

## **MILLARD SCHOOL DISTRICT OFFERS ONLINE EDUCATION PROGRAMS**

Millard School District online education programs will be offered for students at each of our district's three high schools during the current school year. Several courses will be available this year, allowing students to customize their schedules to better meet their academic goals. Students in grades 9-12 may enroll in BYU Independent Study and Millard Education Online (MEO) courses at Delta, EskDale, or Millard High Schools.

In order to enroll in online courses, students must first discuss their interest in taking a particular course and how it will fit into their Plan for College and Career Readiness (PCCR) with their school counselor. Student and Parent Online Course Plans are available from your school to assist students and parents in preparing for the meeting with the counselor. Parents, students, and school counselors must approve the BYU/MEO plan before coursework begins.

Students may complete BYU/MEO courses at home or at school. Each course is assigned a certified teacher who is available for consultation via e-mail and/or at the school by appointment.

Students may sign up for any high school online course available based upon their scheduling needs, counselor and principal approval, and their PCCR plan. When possible, students will be scheduled into regular courses offered at their high school. All online coursework will be paid for by the school district, so long as the student successfully completes the course.
