

DHS Attendance Policy for 2021-22

Tier 1: 3rd absence in a term: teacher makes a phone call home and talks to parent/guardian to express concern about absences from class.

Tier 2: If absences continue, the teacher reports the issue to administration and a parent meeting will be held at the school.

During parent meeting with administration the student/parent will be given the following choices (**all voluntary**) going forward:

- Start attending school and no further action will be taken
- If absences continue the following consequences will occur:
 - Lunch detention
 - In-School Suspension (Crossroads Center)
 - Custodial work after school. (1 absence = 1.5 hours of work)

Tier 3: If absences continue, administration will meet with parents and present them with other options for schooling that might help them in their situation.

- Online or Blended Schedule
- Job Corps
- Adult Ed
- GED
