## **Reunification Plan for Delta High School**


The Delta High School (DHS) safety committee has been working on a reunification plan for our students here at DHS. A reunification plan will help us reunite parents with their student(s) in the event of a school emergency where students would have to leave the campus to be safe. Examples of school emergencies that may require a reunification process include: school intruder, active shooter, bomb or explosive event, or gas leak.

While we hope that this type of emergency never occurs at DHS, we want to have a plan in place that will help everyone (students, school staff, parents, emergency personnel) know how to respond and be reunited with their families in a safe, organized, and efficient manner. In the event of an emergency situation at DHS where students would have to leave the campus to be safe, here is our reunification plan:

1. Teachers/Staff at DHS will help escort students to the Palomar (short 9 minute walk South-West of DHS). See map below.







- Parents/Guardians will be notified by the District using the Student Information System (phone, email, and text). This notification will include the pick-up time and location of students. In order to receive these messages be sure to opt in by texting "Y" to 76587. Also, make sure that school forms are updated with current phone numbers and names.
- 3. Students will only be released to parents, guardians, or other emergency contacts listed in the Student Information System as authorized to check them out.
- 4. If a student is not at the reunification site (Palomar), we will still attempt to contact them and determine if they have been reunited with their parents/guardians. For example, if your student drives to school, depending on the emergency situation, they might have left the campus in their vehicle and will not be present at the reunification site. We will still call and make sure that they are safe and with parents/guardians.
- 5. Patience will be a must. Reunification is a process that protects the safety of the student and provides an accountable change of custody from the school to a recognized custodial parent or guardian. We realize that it will be an emotionally difficult time for everyone, but we ask for your patience and understanding as we reunite you with your student. Thank you.
