Principal's Message

The first quarter came and went quickly. I hope your students are settling into a routine. I noticed some students have been tardy more often since the beginning of the school year. This is a big concern. The number one reason is Delta North teachers care about every child and want them to succeed. Teachers teach from bell to bell and make every minute count. When a student misses the beginning of school, they miss out on vital instruction, which usually results in the teacher taking time from the rest of the class to help the late student get caught up. The second reason is found in the handbook, "To receive full credit at any grade level, students must attend

a minimum of 160 days throughout the school year. Students who miss 21 or more days of school during the regular 177 days are not fully prepared for the next grade.

Excessive tardiness can severely cripple a student's educational program. Habits of punctuality and promptness are important factors of school success (and install responsible habits for later in life). Parents are responsible to make sure their students arrive at school on time. Students who are not in their classrooms when the bell sounds at 8:15 a.m. are late.

Three tardies are treated as

one absence. Students with legitimate excuses for tardiness such as illness, medical appointments, and death of a family member will not be affected by this policy IF the school is made aware of such circumstances. Please also note that parent excused absences are still counted as absences.
