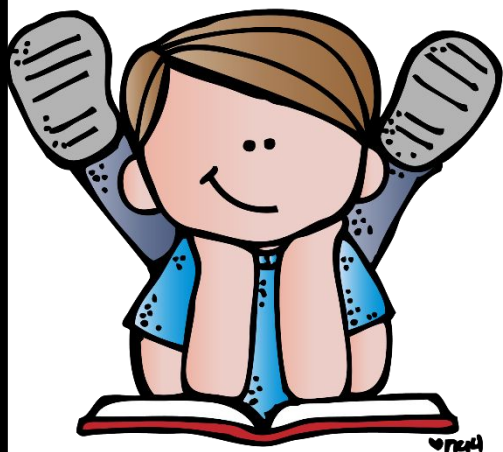


# In 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade I will...

- Solve problems using addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division
- Use place value to round and estimate
- Use fractions on a number line



# In 4<sup>th</sup> Grade I will:



- Demonstrate conventions and use correct grammar, as well as produce complete, complex sentences.
- Use and identify figurative language such as metaphors, similes, and idioms.
- Draw inferences from a text, refer to details in text while supporting my inferences.
- Read and comprehend stories appropriate for a fourth grader.
- Summarize a text telling the most important details and determine the main.
- Describe the overall structure of a text.

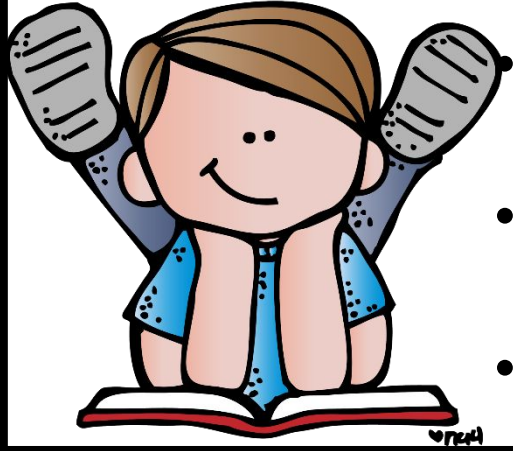
- Organize and compose 1-3 paragraphs opinion and informational essays with introduction and conclusion supported by evidence, details, and main idea.



- Understand place value and perform multi-digit problems up to 1,000,000.
- Master multiplying two-digit numbers and dividing three-digit dividends
- Add and subtract fractions and calculate equivalency
- Round numbers to 100,000

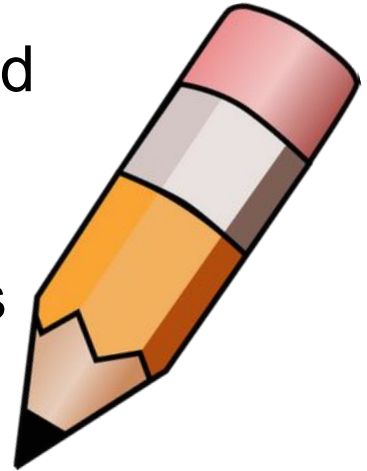


# In 5<sup>th</sup> Grade I will...

- Summarize texts

- Use fractions to add, subtract, multiply, and divide
- Convert measurement units
- Graph points on coordinate
