Carolee presented the "Training Power Point".

*Trust Lands has been built over the years to 3 billion dollars for schools.

*Community Councils are responsible to help use money for the betterment of schools through programs including safety, technology, and academic rigor.

School websites: should include invitations for anyone to attend CC meetings, the agenda, minutes, contact information and plans for trust lands funds and spending. This is planned and recommended by the CC.

Plans should include the following:

*Most critical academic needs and a plan to best address them. They must be measurable and tiered.

*Approval by the Millard School District Board of Education, by February 5th, 2024.

Members reviewed the 2022-23 plan for teacher and student success, as well as the School Trust Land proposal. Last year the money was partially used for the Beverely Taylor Sorenson dance teacher, Instructional aide pay, Letrs Training for teachers, the school musical, and Professional Development/stipends. The total budget was \$96,191 and \$89,000 was the amount spent, leaving \$7,191 as carryover.

Our school needs additional instructional aids. We need at least one more for this year.

Members discussed the need for a new curriculum for ESL. The school is looking into National Geographic materials for our ESL pullouts.
