2. Two Full Time Instructional Assistants

Do we have enough with 2? We could really use another one if we had the funds to do so. We use their help to provide interventions, instruction, and enrichment.

Total: \$55.000

3. Lets Training Stipend

We use this money for research based training to provide knowledge and help to enhance literacy instruction for teachers and improve the reading proficiency of Delta North students.
