Principal's Message

We have made it through the first quarter of school. It has gone by fast and I have a feeling the rest of the year will be the same.

When you attended Parent Conferences, you were given your child's progress data. All students took the DIBELS test in August or September. At Delta North, 62% of our 2nd graders scored at or above benchmark in reading. In Third Grade, 50% of our students read at or above benchmark in reading and 59% of our fourth graders read at or above benchmark in reading. We would like to see at least 70% of our students reading at or above benchmark by the end of the year.

Please look at your students' report and be aware of the many resources available to help if they are struggling. Keep in mind, reading with your child every night for 30 minutes has a big impact on their success in not only reading, but across all subjects.

Interventions are provided at school for those students who are below or well below, to help them become more proficient readers. Students will be tested again in January to determine growth. Delta North's goal is for every student to show adequate growth. Ideally DNES would like to move as many students as possible from "Below and Well Below Benchmark" (Red and Yellow), to "Above or Well Above Benchmark" (Green and Blue). You will be notified of your students' growth throughout the year.

Also, just a reminder that the weather is getting colder. Please make sure your students come dressed for cooler temperatures. Our students remain outside if the temperature is 20 degrees or above. Below 20 degrees, students will be inside for recess.
