When you attended Parent Conferences, you were given your child's progress data. All students took the Acadience Reading assessment in August or September. Delta North has deficits to make up in reading. Many of our students are struggling to become proficient.

We are doing several things to help students progress. Interventions are being carried out at school, trying to help all students become proficient readers. Students will be tested again in January to determine how much growth they have made from the beginning of the year. Delta North's goal is for every student to show growth. Ideally, DNES would like to move as many students as possible from "Below Proficient" (Red and Yellow) levels to "Proficient" or Highly Proficient" (Green and Blue) levels. You will be notified of your students' growth throughout the year.

Please refer to your students' report and be aware of the many resources available to help. Keep in mind reading with your child every night for 30 minutes has a big impact on their success in not only reading, but across all subjects.
