We plan to take advantage of the time to ensure your students are well prepared for the next school year. Our faculty and staff will continue to work hard to help your students succeed in school.

Delta North follows The Leader in Me program. This is a methodology to become a better person. It is based on Dr. Steven Covey's 7 Habits of Highly Successful People, but on an elementary level. We focus on a new habit each month. Each month we have an assembly to learn about our habit for the month and recognize students who were examples of following our last months habit.

January's habit is, "Seek first to understand, then to be understood." The focus is on listening. Please reinforce this at home. Help your child to learn to listen first, then talk. Think how much better the world would be if everyone used this habit.

Using the 7 Habits will help your child build a firm character foundation that is vital to being a better citizen. This will help them take responsibility for their lives, to work with others, and do the right thing, even when no one is looking.

Our students will also be taking the middle of year (MOY) Acadience assessment for math and reading this month. This assessment helps us know if your student is making the progress they need for them to be successful. We will share this information with you in our PCCRs that will be held in February.
