Dear Parents,

Thanks for your support in keeping our students in school. We love having them attend in person and look forward to seeing them every day and watching how they progress!! This time of year many of our students miss school because of illness. We encourage you to continue following these protocols to keep our students well and in school!!

Here are some tips on how to avoid illnesses:

1. Avoid close contact.

Avoid close contact with people who are sick. When you are sick, keep your distance from others to protect them from getting sick too.

2. Stay home when you are sick. If possible, stay home from work, school, and er-

ands. You will help prevent others from catching your illness. If you have a fever, please stay home for at least 24 hours.

3. Clean your hands. Washing your hands often will help protect you from germs. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand rub.

4. Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth.

Germs are often spread when a person touches something that is contaminated with germs and then touches his or her eyes, nose, or mouth.

5. Practice other good health habits. Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces at home, work or school, especially when someone is ill. Get plenty of sleep, be physically active, manage your stress,

drink plenty of fluids, and eat nutritious food.
