

## **EHS Student Dress Code**

**Approved by EHS School Community Council 03/24/2025**

All students should be able to dress comfortably for school without fear of unnecessary discipline or body shaming. The school should be an environment where teachers can focus on teaching without the additional and often uncomfortable burden of dress code enforcement. Dress guidelines and standards shall not discriminate on the basis of any legally protected classification.

### Student Dress Guidelines:

- Students shall be fully dressed. This includes a clothing top and bottom that effectively covers nudity, partial nudity, and undergarments of any kind. Thus, tops must have straps of some sort and must adequately cover the chest and any undergarments there, and bottoms must adequately cover the posterior and any undergarments there.
- Students shall not wear apparel, jewelry, accessories, and/or markings or groom themselves in a manner that depicts obscenity, lewdness, hate, bigotry, violence, or illegal substances.
- Students shall not wear attire with messages targeting groups based on race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, religious affiliation, or any other protected classification.
- Footwear must be worn. Bare or only socked feet are prohibited.
