SECOND GRADE

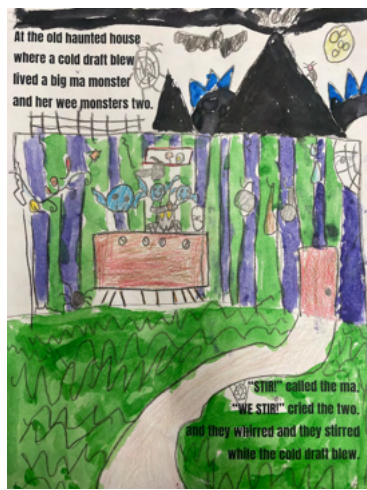
For October, we became illustrators. Using the book "At the Old Haunted House" for inspiration, we drew our own versions of the pictures. Each table had their own page they were working on.

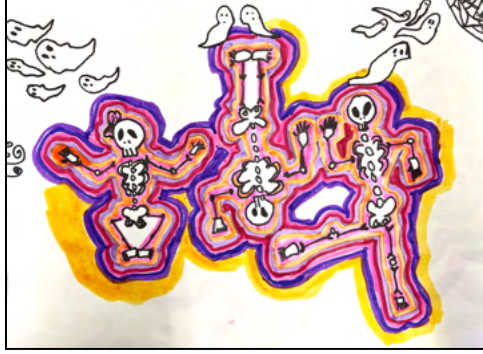
FOURTH GRADE
