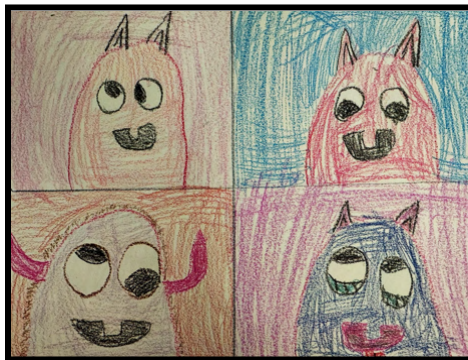


## Kindergarten

## Third Grade

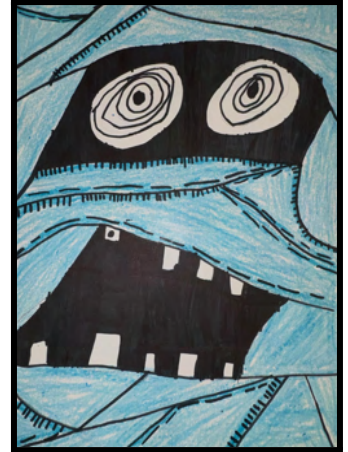

## Fourth Grade

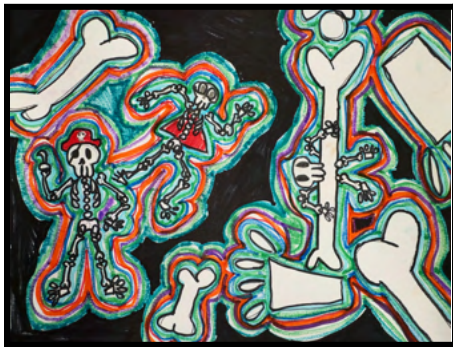
