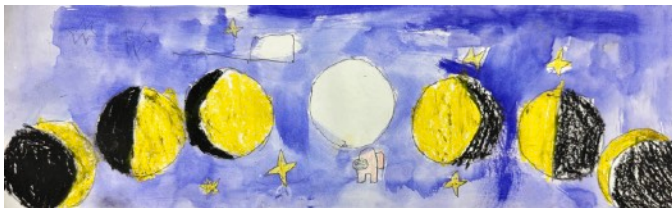

Fourth Grade

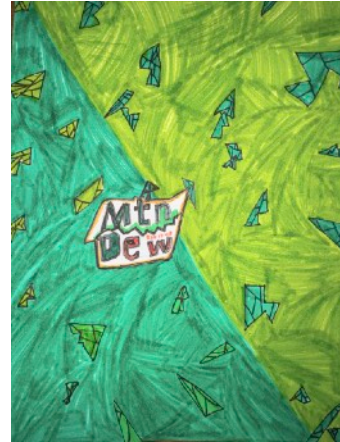
We used Crayola and Sharpie markers to create Pop Art of our favorite candies and drinks. We had to use lines or shapes to help make our art stand out like Pop Art.
