Responsibilities of the Community Council are listed below:

Each school community council shall advise and make recommendations to the school, school district administrators, and the local school board regarding the school and its programs, school district programs, and other issues relating to the community environment for students. Principals shall report activities and progress of the school community council to the Board of Education on a periodic basis.

Each school community council shall also:

- 1. Develop a school improvement plan;
- 2. Develop a School LAND (Learning And Nurturing Development) Trust Program for the school:
- 3. Assist in the development and implementation of a staff professional development plan.

In addition, each school community council for an elementary school with grades K-3 shall develop a reading achievement plan.
