Updated Utah Guidance on Isolation and Quarantine for the General Population and Students

We have new protocols to follow for both isolation and quarantining due to COVID-19. Students and staff will be required to isolate for 5 days (from symptom onset) if they have tested positive for COVID. You may return after the 5 days as long as you have been fever-free for at least 24 hours and your symptoms have improved. You will also be encouraged to wear a mask around others for the next 5 days.

If you have been exposed by someone in your household and have not been vaccinated, you will be required to quarantine for 5 days from the most recent exposure. You can return after the 5 days as long as you are symptom free. You will be encouraged to wear a mask for the next 5 days. If you have been vaccinated, no guarantine is required.

resourceful! We love seeing your imaginations at work. Keep it up!






Lunchroom students for January
