Software – Total \$15,688.27 breakdown follows – set aside \$15,000 for funding through Trustlands.

- I-Ready \$2600.00 Interactive math software 5th / 6th
- IXL \$5583.00 (math and ELA interactive software) 5th / 6th use math & ELA, 7th/8th use ELA.
- ALEKS \$2120.00 (7th / 8th math) Look at pros & cons of implementing for 5th / 6th grade as well ALEKS is used in 4th grade and would examine continuity vs variety.
- Gizmos (interactive science software 5th / 6th grades) \$3300.00.
- Keyboarding \$321.30 5th.
- Vocab Class \$419.97 5th.
- Discovery Kids \$1344.00 Social Science.

District currently paying for: (Possibility may need funding for in the future – not included in Trustlands proposal.) Total \$12,014.42

- Renaissance STAR- Star 360 (reading diagnostic) \$6900.00 (may be used to do a diagnostic for ELL students.
- E Spark \$2585.00
- Scholastic ELA \$2529.42

At this time, we are opting to not renew Lexia and Read 180. Lexia is being replaced by E-spark. Educators like what it offers, also cheaper and easier to use.

Total amount remaining items included in proposal: \$58,376.50.

- Sub incentive will raise the extra pay to \$60 for every 5 sub jobs accepted and carried out at FMS \$2376.50.
- Art specialist wage \$30,000.00 5th-8th Art classes, 7th / 8th craft classes.
- Monthly professional development (faculty meeting) for teachers (\$50 one hour per 10 months outside contract time) \$10,500.00.
- Monthly staff meetings (\$25 every other month 5 months outside contract time.) \$1500.00.
- Professional Development opportunities \$4000.00 (\$200 x 20) ex: Mr. Stuart and Mrs. Freeman recently attended a math conference in Provo where they were shown strategies, different ideas.
- Help subsidize Masters Degrees for interested educators \$10,000.00 (Currently have 6-7 teachers interested in acquiring masters degrees.) Will see if district has funds to help with this as well.
