If you haven't seen yours yet, ask your student.

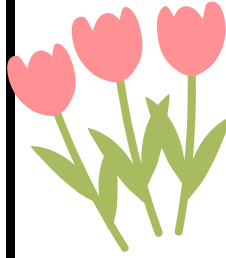

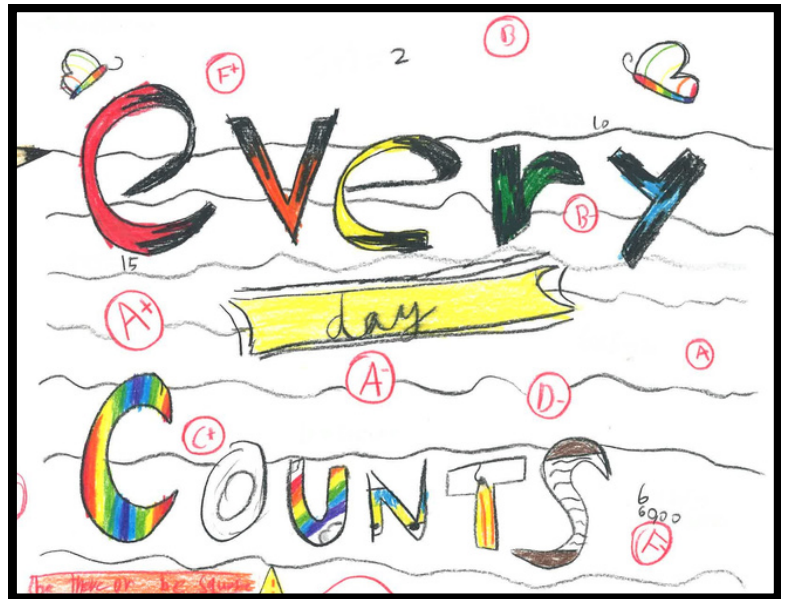
**April Game: Let's grow a PoeTree**
