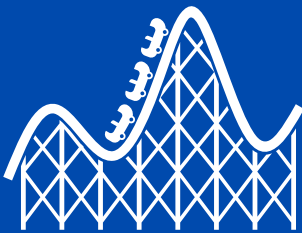
Attention 8th Grade Students Who Want to Go to Lagoon:
