## **Chemical and Biological Spills**

## **Minor Chemical/Biological Spill**

- 1. Alert people in immediate area of the spill
- 2. Minimize the spill
- 3. Read and follow chemical spill information and clean up located on the label of the chemical
- 4. Avoid vapors
- 5. Wear appropriate protective equipment to clean spill area.

## Major Chemical/Biological Spill

- 1. Alert people in area to evacuate
- 2. Attend to any injured personnel and remove them from the area call 911 if needed
- 3. Minimize the spill
- 4. Avoid vapors
- 5. Immediately contact Risk Management 435-864-1022
- 6. Close doors and deny entry to affected area(s)

Note:

- 1. Wear appropriate protective equipment and follow lab procedures to clean spill area until contamination is no longer detected.
- 2. Monitor area, hands, feet, shoes, clothing, etc. for contamination
- 3. Do not bring any chemicals from home. Only use approved chemicals for your use.
- 4. Notify Risk Management 435-864-1022

## **Radiological Material Spill**

- **S Stop** the activity involving the radiological material
- **W Warn** people in the immediate area of the spill
- I Isolate the spill so the spread of contamination is limited
- **M Minimize** the spill
- 1. Wearing appropriate protective equipment, follow lab procedures to clean spill area until contamination is no longer detected.
- 2. Monitor area, hands, feet, shoes, clothing, etc. for contamination
- 3. Notify Risk Management <u>435-864-1022</u>
