

Chemical and Biological Spills

Minor Chemical/Biological Spill

1. Alert people in immediate area of the spill
2. Minimize the spill
3. Read and follow chemical spill information and clean up located on the label of the chemical
4. Avoid vapors
5. Wear appropriate protective equipment to clean spill area.

Major Chemical/Biological Spill

1. Alert people in area to evacuate
2. Attend to any injured personnel and remove them from the area - call 911 if needed
3. Minimize the spill
4. Avoid vapors
5. Immediately contact Risk Management [435-864-1022](tel:435-864-1022)
6. Close doors and deny entry to affected area(s)

Note:

1. Wear appropriate protective equipment and follow lab procedures to clean spill area until contamination is no longer detected.
2. Monitor area, hands, feet, shoes, clothing, etc. for contamination
3. Do not bring any chemicals from home. Only use approved chemicals for your use.
4. Notify Risk Management 435-864-1022

Radiological Material Spill

- **S – Stop** the activity involving the radiological material
 - **W – Warn** people in the immediate area of the spill
 - **I – Isolate** the spill so the spread of contamination is limited
 - **M – Minimize** the spill
1. Wearing appropriate protective equipment, follow lab procedures to clean spill area until contamination is no longer detected.
 2. Monitor area, hands, feet, shoes, clothing, etc. for contamination
