

VISION SCREENING

The Utah Department of Health requires screening students for distance visual acuity for pre-kindergarten, kindergarten, and grades 1, 3, 5, 7 or 8, and 9 or 10. Tenth grade students may be screened as part of their driver education class. Students referred by parent or school personnel should also be screened during any grade. Student in the grades listed above must be screened annually. Additional grades may be screened at the discretion of the local education agency's (LEA). On an annual basis, a written request should be address to the student's School Principal by September 1st to have their student's name removed from the vision screening list.
