PUPIL RULES FOR BUS STUDENTS

1. Pupils should arrive at the bus stop 5 minutes before the bus arrives.
2. Pupils shall wait in a safe place, clear of traffic and away from where the bus stops.
3. Pupils shall wait in an orderly line and avoid horseplay.
4. Pupils shall cross the road or street in front of the bus only after the bus has come to a complete stop and upon direction of the bus driver.
5. Pupils shall go directly to an available or assigned seat when entering the bus.
6. Pupils shall remain seated and keep aisles and exits clear until the bus stops.
7. Pupils shall observe classroom conduct and obey the driver promptly and respectfully.
8. Pupils shall refrain from throwing or passing objects on, from, or into buses.
9. Pupils are permitted to carry only objects that can be held in his/her lap.
10. Pupils shall refrain from the use of profane language, tobacco/electronic cigarettes, alcohol, drugs, or any other controlled substance on the bus.
11. Pupils shall refrain from eating and drinking on the bus except by special permission from the driver.
12. Pupils shall not carry nuisance items, animals, or hazardous materials such as knives, guns, or weapons onto the bus.
13. Pupils shall respect the rights and safety of others.
14. Pupils shall refrain from leaving or boarding the bus at locations other than the assigned stops or school.
15. Pupils shall refrain from extending head, arms, or objects out of the bus window.
16. Pupils shall refrain from hitching rides via the rear bumper or other parts of the bus.
17. Any damage to the bus must be paid for by the student(s) responsible for the damage.

APPENDIX C File Code: 3040 PUPIL CONSEQUENCES

1ST Violation – Student warned by the driver.

2nd Violation – Student assigned a designated seat.

3rd Violation – Principal and parent called. Student off the bus up to 3 school days.

4th Violation ** - Principal and parent called. Student off the bus up to 4 school days.

Severe Cause – Safe School Violation – Student off the bus. Principal and parent notified that a meeting with the superintendent is required before the student may ride again.

** If repeated violation still occurs after the 4th violation, the student is off the bus for 10 days. Principal and parents are notified that the student will meet with the superintendent before getting back on the bus. The superintendent will determine if riding privileges of the pupil should be terminated permanently or a probation plan should be put in place.
