

School Meal Update
September 17, 2020

The USDA has approved a waiver for schools to again provide free meals for our students. This program has been approved to run through December 31, 2020 or until funds run out.

This program will run a little differently than the way meals were provided in the Spring. The following regulations must be followed:

- Meals will be available at all Delta and Fillmore area schools.
- Meals will **only be available for students registered in one of these schools**. Students can either be attending in person or through one of our district offered online programs.
- Meals will need to be picked up inside the cafeteria of the school where your student is registered at the designated time. We are not able to deliver to outlying areas.
- Plan on picking up meals between 11:30-11:45 am.
- Parents with online students will be asked to fill out a survey each night if they will be picking up a meal the next day. This will help with our meal counts.
- Students enrolled in one of the district's online programs will receive breakfast for the next day when picking up lunch.

The USDA cannot guarantee the length of this free meal waiver. Due to the unknown expiration of this waiver, we encourage parents to continue to apply for free and reduced meal eligibility so students will not have a lapse in benefits.
