Application Procedure: To find position announcement and application, log on to www.snow.edu. To be considered for employment, you must complete the hiring packet which must include:

- Snow College employment application
- Cover letter
- Resume/Vita
- Three current letters of recommendation: All letters must have been written within a year of the closing date, be signed and dated, and be from a person having firsthand knowledge of the applicant's professional qualifications.
- Applicants are responsible to submit an original hiring packet, plus one additional copy.

Qualifications:

- Must have excellent people skills, be able to work as a team member, and be skilled at problem solving
- Must be a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN)
- Preference given to Registered Nurse (RN) or advanced degrees
- Must have a current license to practice as an LPN or RN in the State of Utah
- Must have one year full-time in long term care and two years nursing experience.
- Teaching experience preferred
- Must pass fingerprint and background check
- Must have basic general computer literacy skills.

Major Duties:

- Teach classroom theory and supervise clinical experiences under the supervision of the Allied Health Director
- Prepare and review curriculum to meet current industry standards
- Supervise, teach, test and grade students
- Actively recruit qualified students into program
- Advise students to ensure success in the program
- Be willing to supervise clinicals, including extended hours
- Coordinate all CPR instruction in the region
- Teach CPR to CNA students
- Perform such other tasks and assume such other duties and responsibilities as may be assigned.

Wage: Hourly wage is based on a 9-month teaching contract according to qualification, background and experience granted at hire. This position does not have benefits.
