Consideration of Financial Assistance for Delta High School and Millard High School Because of COVID-19 related issues

Because of limitations placed on the number of individuals that could attend the winter sports, the gate receipts are way down from previous years and in many cases, the gate receipts were insufficient to pay for the officials. Also, Delta High School and Millard High School use the gate receipts from the fall and winter sports to pay for the officials and other costs for the non-revenue producing spring activities.

It was recommended that the Board of Education approve a dollar amount from the District to support these activities.
