These folks spoke against the wearing of masks mandate from the Utah Department of Health. It was indicated that parents should have the right to decide if their child wears a mask to school. Mrs. Gardner referenced Utah Code 62A-4a-2001: "Under both the United States Constitution and the Constitution of the State of Utah, a parent possesses a fundamental liberty interest in the care, custody, and management of the parents' children".

It was requested that the Millard School District Board of Education consider removing the wearing of masks mandate that has been issued by the Utah Department of Health.

It was suggested that parents be given the option of signing an exemption form to release individual students from wearing their mask.

Shawn Works asked if the wearing of masks was financial or health driven. Superintendent Styler expressed that at the beginning it was financial, as if the District did not present a "school reopening plan", funding would be withheld. Mr. Works also expressed concern and frustration about the Delta High School graduation being held in the auditorium, with the graduating seniors only getting five (5) tickets. This parent asked, "who gets left out of attending graduation?"

1. Member Barney expressed appreciation for the opportunity of being a member of the Millard School District Board of Education. She expressed appreciation for the individuals who were honored this day for their retirement. These are great individuals who have contributed much making the Millard School District a great place for students.

She expressed appreciation for those present for the presentation of removing the mandate for wearing masks.

2. Member Lund seconded the comments made by Mrs. Barney regarding the individuals who are retiring. Each have contributed much to enrich the lives of our children.

Member Lund thanked those present for the presentation on removing the wearing of masks mandate to take a stand and express their opinion regarding this issue. He indicated that their comments have not fallen on deaf ears and that comments will be taken into consideration.
