# <u>Delta Middle School Faculty – Presentation of Personalized, Competency-Based Learning and Allocation of Time</u>

DMS Faculty Presentation and Discussion

Members of the Delta Middle School faculty presented on Personalized, Competency-Based Learning (PCBL). DMS faculty will be implementing software that will aid in the adoption of PCBL methods. The presenters stressed the time commitment involved in such an adoption and asked the Board for additional preparation time – in the form of an early out school-wide on Fridays during the 2022-2023 school year – to compensate.

The Board mentioned that it does desire to help the teachers with extra preparation time, but that there is work to do on the logistics of such an undertaking. Continued research and discussion will take place regarding this.
