Mrs. Jody Anderson requested to be on the Board of Education agenda to discuss allowing incoming freshman girls the opportunity to participate on the cheerleading squad. Mrs. Anderson explained that this will affect generations of students for years to come.

Mrs. Anderson reported to the Members of the Board that after having checked with other schools, Delta High School is the only cheer squad that she could find that does not allow all grades to participate in cheerleading, including Millard High School in our own District. This is the only activity that the Delta High School provides that freshman cannot participate in. Mrs. Anderson indicated that the last thing anyone would want to do is discourage students being involved.

Mrs. Anderson indicated that it just isn't fair that ninth grade girls are not being able to be on the Delta High School cheerleading team. Mrs. Anderson had called the Utah High School Activities Association (UHSAA) who indicated that cheerleading will be on the agenda for the March Board of Trustees meeting to be considered as a sanctioned sport with State competition. If this is approved for cheerleading, it may make this a moot point depending on how the requirements are set by the UHSAA.
