1. Millard shall count students residing in Utah for apportionment purposes in accordance with Utah law. White Pine shall count students residing in Nevada for apportionment purposes in accordance with Nevada law.
2. For each Nevada student who attends school in Millard County, White Pine shall pay Millard a per pupil amount equal to the amount Millard expended per pupil during the previous school year, including special education expenses.
3. For each Utah student who attends school in White Pine County, Millard shall pay White Pine a per pupil amount equal to the per pupil basic support for the current school year, including special education funding per student.

Member Britt was pleased with the presentation from Japheth McGee of Zions Public Finance. He felt that the presentation gave him useful information as he speaks with members of the public. He noted the tragedy of the passing of a MHS student the prior week. He mentioned he was grateful for the District’s crisis team. He also mentioned that the Board’s thoughts and prayers go out to the family affected.

Member Nelson offered congratulations to the high school graduates and also to those retiring graduates (employees retiring from the District). She commended Mr. Callister for the great job he is doing at the tech center. She was also impressed with the FFA program and mentioned that during the FFA Banquet over \$19,000 of scholarships were awarded to DHS FFA students. She also lauded the work the Delta North Elementary students do at the care center and the joy that it brings the residents and the kids.

Member Richins mentioned she was excited for all the high school graduates and that she is excited to attend the coming graduations. She also noted her excitement for the District retirees, and for the time, effort, and care they put into their careers. She expressed that the District will miss having them and that they have each left big shoes to fill. She also mentioned that she was impressed with the Academic All-State award recipients.

Member Finlinson echoed prior comments. She said that her heart goes out to those affected by recent tragedies in our community. She mentioned her excitement for the District retirees and expressed that she feels that “thank you” seems inadequate for the work and effort they have put into their careers working with students. She mentioned her gratitude for them and for those that continue to work in the District.

Member Lund also echoed the previous comments. He expressed sorrow for the recent tragedies but also pointed out the good things that continue to happen in the community. He is excited about the upcoming projects and changes in the District. He looks forward to attending graduations and seeing the graduates move on to the next phase of their lives. Member Lund also expressed appreciation for the Board Members. He mentioned that although they may not always agree on every decision, they walk out of Board Meeting as friends.

He expressed his appreciation for our teachers as we get to the end of the school year. He also mentioned that his heart goes out to those affected by recent tragedy, and he stressed the pain felt at losing any member of our District family. He expressed his gratitude for the Board and all they do.

Corey Holyoak also agreed with all other comments. He also expressed his sympathies for those affected by the recent tragedies in the community. He expressed appreciation for the District retirees and for the work and effort they have put into their careers, and he mentioned that he is grateful that his kids in the school system are in great hands.
